Below is the Mary Rose's mums Fudge recipe that was a favourite for everyone ☺

1 packet plus 3-4 Super wine biscuits

¼ 1b butter

¼ 1b sugar

Tablespoon cocoa

1 egg

Small teaspoon vanilla essence

Walnuts (optional)

Crush biscuits. Put sugar, butter, cocoa, vanilla essence and beaten egg in a pan. Stirring bring to boil slowly. Add crushed biscuits. Press into a lightly greased Swiss roll tin, leave to cool then ice with chocolate icing.

Cut into pieces, eat and enjoy.
